MEMORANDUM FOR EXECUTIVE OFFICERS GROUP

Subject: Funding for Federal Executive Boards

In order to carry out their work on behalf of Federal Executive Boards, it will be necessary for the individuals serving in the capacity of executive assistants to the chairmen and as secretaries to the Board, be given certain administrative support. Such support should be directly provided by the agencies which employ the individuals involved (see attached list). This is the approved method to assure an adequate support level for FEBs while systematizing the manner in which this support is provided.

I presently envision that the required level of support would normally not exceed \$5,000-\$7,000 (exclusive of salaries) depending on local considerations. This would include printing, travel, general office and other costs incurred in connection with their work with Federal Executive Boards. I urge you to contact the executive assistant(s) employed by your agency in order to determine specific needs.

In order to conform to the budgetary requirements of some agencies, this arrangement should take effect with the start of fiscal year 1973.

This seems an appropriate opportunity to express to you my gratitude for all the support and cooperation which you and your agency have given to FEBs. I would like you to know that it is deeply appreciated by us at OMB.
